**Comments:** I am writing on behalf of Horsham Society to object to application DC/15/2588, for the following reasons:- a) The perimeter railings are detailed as being 1200mm high. This is excessive as they will be constructed on a brick retaining wall. A maximum height of 900mm to 1000mm should be considered. b) Size of the proposed illuminated signage is considered excessive for the site. Furthermore if illuminated signs are approved, there should be restrictions imposed limiting the lighting to between the hours of 9.00am and 6.00pm. c) Access to the site is a major considered a major problem, as the site is accessed through a residential area, on a one way system.
