On behalf of Horsham Society, I wish to lodge an objection to Planning Application DC/17/0626.

The height of the sign which is proposed for the West elevation is too high and should be lowered, moving it from the gable end and siting it immediately below the eaves line.

As a result of erecting new signage, the existing plastic banner signs, that presently serve to deface the building elevations (particularly the sign erected on the West elevation) should be removed.
